Year 4 Trip to The Dorset Museum, Dorchester – Wednesday 6th May 2026

As part of our History unit on the Roman Empire, we will be visiting The Dorset Museum in Dorchester, on the 6th May. This half term, our learning will be focussing on the impact of the Romans on Britain including a local study on the Roman town of Durnovaria (Dorchester). At the museum, the children will have an opportunity to experience handling Roman objects and observing Roman artefacts on display as well as visiting a Roman town house, a short walk from the museum.
