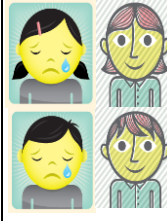

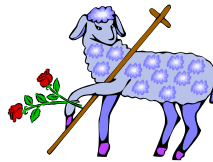

John 11:1-45

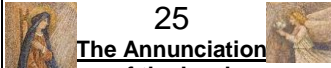

Do something special for someone you care about today.

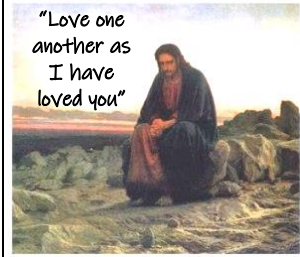

"Love one another as I have loved you"

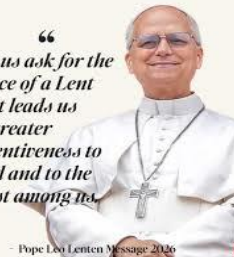
